

Installation of Jitterbits Dictionary Pocket PC Edition

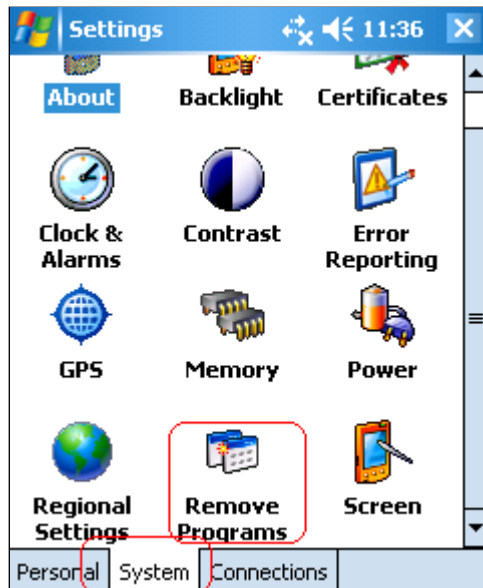
Describes in details the installation and uninstallation of the Jitterbits Dictionary and the manual installation of a proper dictionary font

Uninstallation of the Previous Jitterbits Installation

If you have a previous version of the *Jitterbits Dictionary* installed on your device you don't need to specifically uninstall it. But if you have the same version, as the one you plan to install currently, please first uninstall it. To do this, tap on *Start / Settings* menu, select the *System* tab and then tap on the *Remove Programs* icon.



Locate and select the installed *Jitterbits Dictionary* in the list of installed programs and then tap on the *Remove* button.

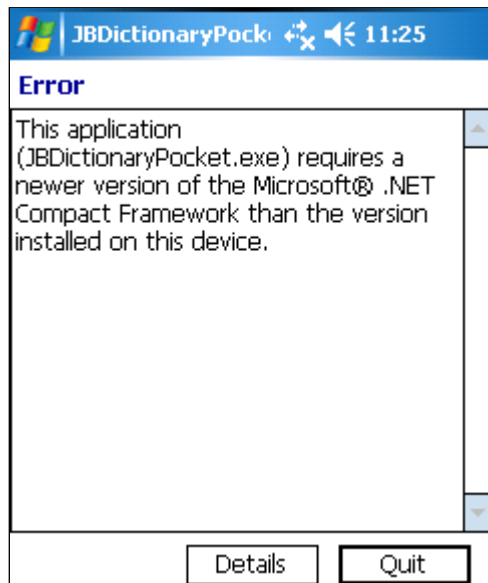


Confirm the program removal. The installation wizard will remove the installed version of *Jitterbits Dictionary*.

Installation of Microsoft .Net Compact Framework

In order to run *Jitterbits Dictionary* on your device you need to have the *Microsoft .NET Compact Framework version 2.0 or higher* installed on your device. If you have already *.NET Compact*

Framework version 2.0 or higher installed on your device, you can skip this step. If you don't, you will get a message similar to the following, as soon as you try to run the *Jitterbits Dictionary* for the first time.

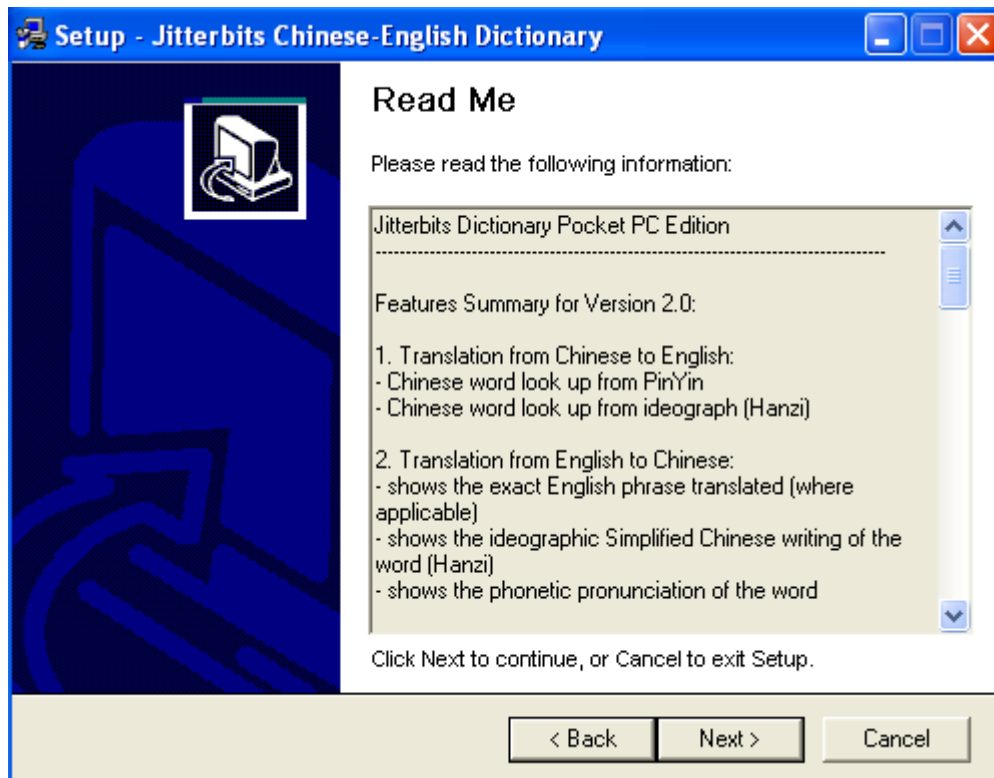
Please download and install the *Microsoft .NET Compact Framework*, and then run the *Jitterbits Dictionary* setup wizard again.

Installation of the Jitterbits Dictionary

Locate the installation file of the *Jitterbits Dictionary*. If the downloaded file is in *zip*-format, first extract the *.exe* installation file. Double click on the *.exe* file to start the installation of the product. The product setup wizard will show up.

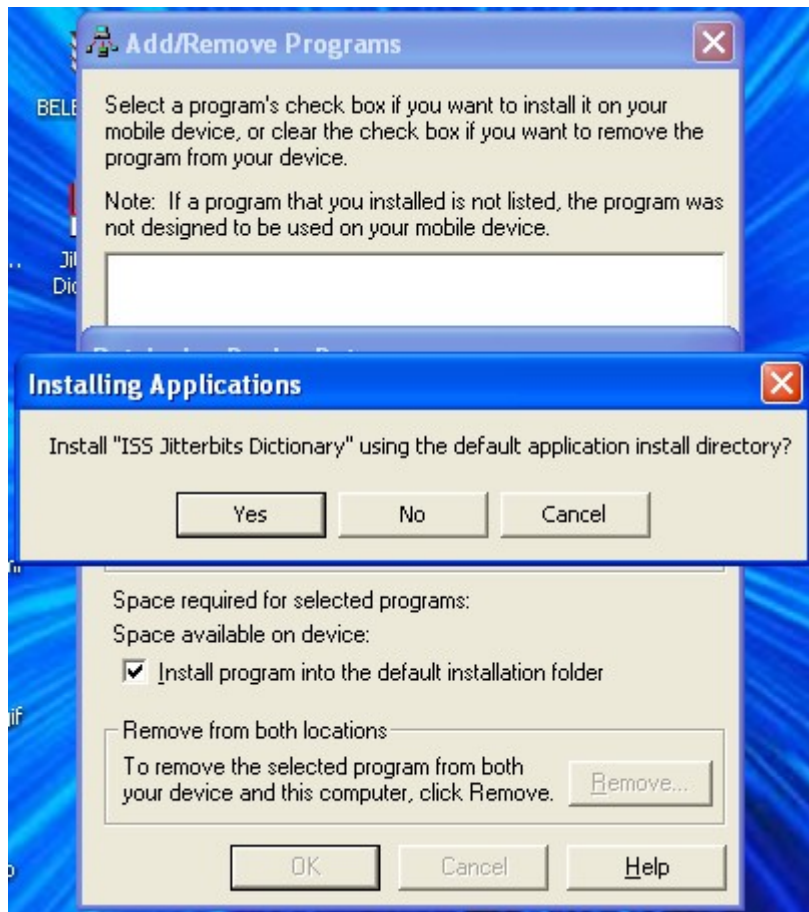
On the *Welcome* screen press the button *Next*. On the *Read Me* screen press also the button *Next*.



On the *License Agreement* screen press the button *Yes* to continue.



The *Add/Remove Programs* screen will show up. Press the *Yes* button to start the installation or reinstallation of *Jitterbits Dictionary* on the device.

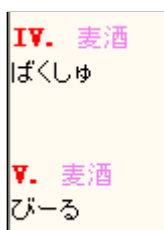


The setup wizard will copy the product files to the specified installation folder. After a successful installation you will get the *Jitterbits Dictionary* icon on *Programs* folder of your device. Tap on it to run the *Jitterbits Dictionary*.

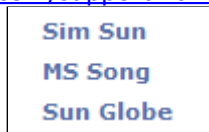


Manual Installation of a Proper Font

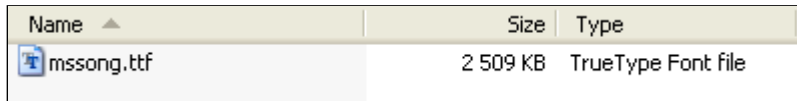
If you plan to use the *Chinese-English* or *Japanese-English* translations, you would need a proper font installed. The font should contain the graphical representations of all needed characters.



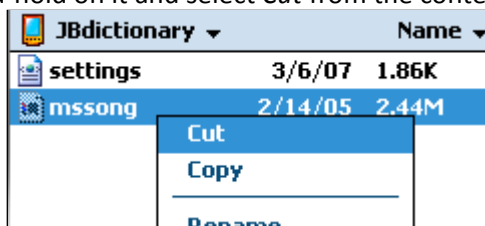
You can download manually a proper font from our support web page - <http://www.iss-bg.com/support.html#jbdict>



Normally the downloaded file is in *zip*-format. Please first extract the font it into temporary folder.



Copy the *TTF* file to your device. On the device, start the *File Explorer*, locate the copied font file, tap-and-hold on it and select *Cut* from the context menu.



Then go to `\Windows\Fonts` folder, tap-and-hold anywhere on it and select *Paste* from the context menu. This way the font file will be moved to the system font folder.



Then soft reset the device. This will install the copied font.

Finally, run the *Jitterbits Dictionary*. Tap on *Options / Settings* menu. The *Settings* dialog will show up. Tap on *A*-button and select the newly installed font. The new font will become the default font used by the *Jitterbits Dictionary*.
